### Program Descriptions

#### Chat With a Ranger

1 hour. Meet at in Wuksachi Lobby. Drop by at your leisure for help planning your visit.

#### Clover Creek Critters

1.5 hours; 1 mile. Meet at Wuksachi Lodge. Join a Sequoia Natural History Association Naturalist on a short walk to Clover Creek for a hands-on discovery of local insects and fish.

#### Critter Talk

30 minutes. Meet at the Lodgepole Visitor Center. Discover more about the animals that call Sequoia National Park home.

#### Lodgepole Campfire

1 hour. Meet at the Lodgepole Campground Amphitheater near Loop B. Topics vary.

#### Lodgepole Kids Campfire

30 minutes. Meet at the Lodgepole Campground Amphitheater near Loop B.

*Sunday: Giant Sequoias*

#### Moro Vista Talk

20 minutes. Meet the ranger on top of Moro Rock. 1/3-mile climb up a stone staircase. Enjoy sweeping vistas and learn about your National Park!

#### Realm of Giants Walk

2 hours; 1 mile. Meet at Giant Forest Museum. Deepen your understanding and appreciation of the world's largest trees.

#### Sherman Tree Talk

20 minutes. Meet at the base of the General Sherman Tree. Learn about the largest tree on the planet and its secrets for survival.

#### Wonders of the Night Sky

1 hour; ½ mile. Meet in Wuksachi Lobby. Join a Sequoia Natural History Association naturalist to explore the beauty and wonder of the parks' protected sky. Bring warm layers and a flashlight.

#### Voices of the Past

1 hour. Meet on the Wolverton Patio. Travel back in time with a Sequoia National History Association naturalist to see the park through a living history character.

#### Sherman Tree Lantern Tour

1.5 hours; 1 mile. Meet at the Main Sherman Tree parking lot. Walk to the largest tree on Earth with a historical character living in Giant Forest in the early 1940s.

#### Full Moon on Moro Rock

1 hour. Meet a Sequoia Natural History Association Naturalist at the top of Moro Rock. Listen to some science and cultural stories as the moon rises.
