Program Descriptions

Big Tree Talk: Meet a ranger at the base of the General Grant Tree to find out what it takes to be one of the largest trees on earth. *20 minutes.* 

Ranger in the Grove: How big? How old? What happens in a fire? Look for a ranger or volunteer naturalist along the Grant Tree Trail to have your giant sequoia questions answered. *Informal, ongoing.* 

Grant Tree Walk: Learn about the giant sequoias and why people have been coming to Grant Grove for centuries. Meet a ranger in the Grant Tree parking lot. This easy stroll through the grove is suitable for all ages and fitness levels. *1 hour, ½ mile.*
