Grant Tree Walk

Learn about the massive giant sequoias and why people have been coming to Grant Grove for centuries. Meet in the Grant Tree parking lot for this easy walk through the grove. *1 hour, ½-mile walk*

Celebrate International Migratory Bird Day 2013

Join Forest Service Wildlife Biologist Jeff Cordes in front of the Kings Canyon Visitor Center on Saturday May 18, anytime between 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. to learn about the importance of migratory birds. Free materials will be available along with stories of birds commonly found in the area. International Migratory Bird Day is the largest-known conservation and education event of its kind in the Western Hemisphere. Created in 1993, this celebration event increases public awareness and involvement in bird conservation. This year's theme is bird life cycles and focuses on all aspects of a migratory birds' life, from nesting and migration to breeding and raising young. Most importantly, it addresses the need for conservation throughout the life cycle.
