Program Descriptions

Big Tree Talk: Some of the sequoias in Kings Canyon National Park tower more than 300 feet tall, and the world-famous Grant Tree is more than 40 feet wide at its base. Meet a ranger at the base of the General Grant Tree to find out what it takes to be one of the largest trees on earth. *20 minutes.* 

Evening Program: Join a ranger in the lobby of the John Muir Lodge for a short talk and 45 minute showing of Ken Burns' film, *The National Parks: America's Best Idea*. This documentary tells the story of an idea as uniquely American as the Declaration of Independence and just as radical: that the most special places in the nation should be preserved, not for royalty or the rich, but for everyone. *1 hour.*
