Program Descriptions

Big Tree Talk:

Some of the sequoias in Kings Canyon National Park tower more than 300 feet tall, and the world-famous Grant Tree is more than 40 feet wide at its base. Meet a ranger at the base of the General Grant Tree to find out what it takes to be one of the largest trees on earth. *20 minutes.* 

Ranger in the Grove:

How big? How old? What happens in a fire? Look for a ranger or volunteer naturalist along the Grant Tree Trail to have your giant sequoia questions answered. *Informal, ongoing.*
