Program Descriptions

Big Tree Talk: Meet a ranger at the base of the General Grant Tree to learn what it takes to be one of the largest trees on Earth. *15 minutes.* ♿

Evening Program: Meet in the lobby of the John Muir Lodge for a talk, slide show, or film about the people, places and things that make Kings Canyon National Park so special. *1 hour.* ♿

Grant Tree Walk: Learn about the giant sequoias and why people have been coming to Grant Grove for centuries. Meet in the Grant Tree parking lot for this easy walk through the grove. *1 hour, ½-mile walk.* ♿

Twilight Stroll: As visitors to Grant Grove are getting ready to go to bed, many residents are just starting their “day”. Bring a flashlight and meet Ranger Farrah in front of the Visitor Center to learn more about these creatures of the night. *1 hour, 1-mile walk.*
