

## HIGHWAY SCHEDULE FOR WEEK OF AUGUST 10th THROUGH 14th:

HOURS OF OPERATION: Monday - Friday 6AM - 6PM (no night work scheduled for this week). No scheduled weekend work other than dust control.

### PROJECT FOCUS AND DELAY SCHEDULE FOR THIS WEEK:

*Little Baldy summit to just north of Red Fir Maintenance intersection:* Expect a 5 mile escort through the construction zone.

Delay Schedule: One hour delays 8 AM to 4PM with pass through from both directions of travel at top of the hour. Half hour delays 6AM to 7:30AM and 4:30PM to 6PM with pass through from both directions of travel at the top and bottom of the hour.

*Wuksachi Road to Clover Creek Bridge intersection:* Expect minor delays up to 15 min. maximum for shoulder work within this area.

*Please note there will continue to be areas of unpaved roadway which will be signed accordingly. Travelers, especially motorcycle and bicycle riders, should exercise caution.*

## SPECIAL NOTE IN WORK SCHEDULE FOR WEEK OF AUGUST 16TH:

In addition to the daily work schedule, the contractor will be exercising their option per contract to perform night work beginning the week of August 16th. The plan calls for night closures to begin on Sunday evening, August 16th at 9PM and to continue through Friday morning (August 21st) until 5AM.

Night Work project focus and schedule per contract agreement is as follows:

**Schedule: Dates; August 16th – 21st**

**Time: 9:00PM through 5:00AM with one traffic pass thru from both directions of travel at 11:30PM. Once the 11:30 PM queued traffic passes through the construction zone the road will close until 5AM. It will reopen to free flowing traffic until the day schedule goes into effect at 6AM. In addition from 6PM to 9PM traffic will be free flowing until the road closure occurs at 9PM.**

Regulated Traffic Zone: The Generals Highway road closure will be the segment from Little Baldy summit to the Red Fir Maintenance intersection.

The current Variable Message Signs (VMS) located near Grant Grove will be changed late Friday 8/14 to advertise the night closure schedule.
