

The following is the **Highway Schedule for the week of Oct. 12th – 16th.**

Please take note of changes in hours of operation, area of construction, and affected facilities.

HOURS OF OPERATION: Monday - Friday 7:00AM - 6:00PM. **The contractor will be working regular hours of operation Monday Columbus Day (Oct 12th).** No night or weekend work other than for dust control.

PROJECT FOCUS AND DELAY SCHEDULE FOR THIS WEEK:

1. North of Suwanee Creek to just south of the Lodgepole Village Road intersection. Expect a 6 mile escort through the construction zone. To accommodate traffic flow, at times the pilot car escort locations may be reduced to less than 6 miles, however this is tentative and random. To assist park operations, road construction traffic control will contact Park Dispatch to announce changes in traffic control locations, monitor the radio for updates.

Delay Schedule:

One hour delays 8 AM to 4PM with pass through from both directions of travel at top of the hour. Road closure at 7:00 AM with half hour delays at 7:30AM and 4:30PM to 6:00PM, with pass through from both directions of travel on the hour and the half hour. In addition to the General's Highway traffic control stations there will be flaggers stationed at the Lodgepole Village intersection and Wuksachi Road intersection and Red Fir Maint. intersection. The Red Fir Sprayfield intersection as well as Clover Creek Waste Water Treatment Plant intersection will be under traffic control restrictions posted "Wait For Pilot Car". Delays will be a maximum of one hour with traffic flowing from the two main traffic control points at the top of the hour, with side roads passing with the last car of the traffic queue per respective direction of travel.

2. Wuksachi Road

Tentatively pulverizing and paving on the Wuksachi Road will begin (weather permitting).

Delay Schedule:

Flaggers will be stationed at both ends of the project area, signs posted "Wait For Pilot Car" at side entry roads with minimal delay pilot car escorts during hours of operation. Vehicles exiting the Wuksachi Village will be escorted to the Generals Highway and staged along the Generals Highway until the respective Generals Highway pilot cars escort the vehicles outside the construction zone on the Generals Highway. Vehicles entering Wuksachi Road will be escorted via pilot car to the Village.

Please note:

- Pulverizing will continue this week, once again resulting in areas of unpaved roadway signed accordingly. Travelers, especially motorcycle and bicycle riders, need to be cautious on these sections.
- During this construction period the Lodgepole Picnic area and Clover Creek pullout will be closed for public use until further notice.
- Employees and visitors using side access roads between the Red Fir Maintenance facility and Wolverton intersection need to adjust their travel into and out of the respective areas to coincide with the traffic delay schedule.
- Intersections off of the Generals Highway may experience increased congestion. Flaggers are working to accommodate traffic moving in both directions. Please use extra caution and expect slowing traffic in these areas.
