

The following is the **Highway Schedule for the week of Sept. 28th - Oct. 2nd**. Please take note of changes in hours of operation, area of construction, and affected facilities.
No night or weekend work is planned other than for dust control.

PROJECT FOCUS AND DELAY SCHEDULE FOR THIS WEEK:

1. South of Red Fir Maintenance intersection to just south of the Wolverton Road intersection. (Monday - Friday 6: 30AM - 6:00PM) *The work zone may move ½ mile north of the Wolverton Road intersection to one mile north of the Red Fir Maint. intersection during the latter part of the week.*

Delay Schedule:

One hour delays 8 AM to 4PM with pass through from both directions of travel at top of the hour. Half hour delays 6:30AM to 7:30AM and 4:30PM to 6:00PM, with pass through from both directions of travel on the hour and the half hour. In addition to the General's Highway traffic control stations there will be flaggers stationed at the Wolverton intersection, Lodgepole Village intersection, and Wuksachi Road intersection. **During the latter part of the week Wolverton Road intersection may be relieved of traffic control. However the Red Fir Maint. intersection will be under traffic control restrictions (posted "Wait For Pilot Car").** Delays will be a maximum of one hour with traffic flowing from the two main traffic control points at the top of the hour, with side roads passing with the last car of the traffic queue per respective direction of travel.

2. South of the Red Fir Maintenance intersection to Little Baldy Summit. (Monday - Friday 6: 30AM - 6:00PM)

In addition to the construction in the Red Fir to Wolverton area along the General's Highway, there will be road construction work in the Halstead Meadow area with flaggers controlling the flow of traffic. Delays will be minimal, not exceeding 10 min.

3. Wuksachi Road (Friday)

Pulverization of the Wuksachi Road will tentatively begin on Friday, October 2. Traffic control will be in place. A finalized traffic plan will be distributed early next week when it is available.

Please note:

- Pulverizing will continue this week, once again resulting in areas of unpaved roadway signed accordingly. Travelers, especially motorcycle and bicycle riders, need to be cautious on these sections.
- During this construction period the Lodgepole Picnic area and Clover Creek pullout will be closed for public use until further notice.
- Employees and visitors using side access roads between the Red Fir Maintenance facility and Wolverton intersection need to adjust their travel into and out of the respective areas to coincide with the traffic delay schedule.
- Intersections off of the Generals Highway may experience increased congestion. Flaggers are working to accommodate traffic moving in both directions. Please use extra caution and expect slowing traffic in these areas.

In addition to the Federal Highway General's Highway project, the SEKI Road Crew will be performing road repair work along the Generals Highway between Big Baldy Summit and Kings Canyon Overlook this week. Delays will be minimal, averaging 5 minutes between pilot car escort. Hours of operation 7:30 AM to 5:00 PM.
