

PLEASE NOTE: The road construction project is coming close to completion. This week's escorted traffic control zone reflects the incidental and random sites requiring final refinement and completion of the project. In order to ensure the safety of project staff as well as visitors and employees restricted travel through the project zone is necessary. As work is completed in the southern area of the project, south of the Red Fir Maintenance intersection the contractor will release escorted traffic control and replace it with incidental flagging operations will minimal delays. Please be patient in these waning days of construction (south of Red Fir) and yield to traffic control restrictions. The safety of all is of utmost importance; please do not compromise your safety as well as others by entering areas of restricted travel without proper clearance.

The following is the Highway Schedule for the week of Nov. 2nd – 6th. Please take note of changes in hours of operation, area of construction, and affected facilities.

HOURS OF OPERATION: Monday - Friday 6:30AM - 5:00PM. No night or weekend work other than for dust control.

PROJECT FOCUS AND DELAY SCHEDULE FOR THIS WEEK:

Near Little Baldy summit to south of the Wolverton Road intersection. Expect an 8 mile escort through the construction zone. To accommodate traffic flow, at times the pilot car escort locations may be reduced to less than 8 miles, however this is tentative and random. To assist park operations road construction traffic control will contact Park Dispatch to announce changes in traffic control locations, monitor the radio for updates.

Delay Schedule:

Half hour delays will be in place throughout the daily operation. Road closure at 6:30 AM with half hour delays beginning at 7:00AM and continuing through 5:00PM. Traffic pass through from both directions of travel will be on the hour and half hour. Flaggers will be stationed at the Wuksachi Road, Lodgepole Village, and Wolverton Road intersections. The Lodgepole Residential Road and Picnic intersection, Red Fir Maintenance Facility and Sprayfield intersection as well as Clover Creek Waste Water Treatment Plant intersection will be under traffic control restrictions posted "Wait For Pilot Car". Delays will be a maximum of one half hour with traffic flowing from the two main traffic control points at the top and bottom of the hour, with side roads passing with the last car of the traffic queue per respective direction of travel.

Please note:

- The Clover Creek pullout will remain closed for public use until further notice.
- Employees and visitors using side access roads between the Red Fir Maintenance facility and Wolverton Road intersection need to adjust their travel into and out of the respective areas to coincide with the traffic delay schedule.
- Intersections off of the Generals Highway may experience increased congestion. Flaggers are working to accommodate traffic moving in both directions. Please use extra caution and expect slowing traffic in these areas.
