## Grant Tree Walk

Go on a leisurely walk to learn about the giant sequoias and why people have been coming to Grant Grove for centuries. Meet at the trailhead in the Grant Tree parking lot. *1 hour, ½ mile walk, easy*

## Kings Canyon: Beyond the Sequoias

There is more to Kings Canyon than big trees! Discover the animals, plants, geology, or history that makes Kings Canyon National Park unique. Meet at the Kings Canyon Visitor Center for this family-friendly ranger talk. *20-30 minute talk*

## Solitude in the Sequoias Walk

Meet at the Grant Tree parking lot to discover a quiet region of a magnificent Sequoia Grove. Join a ranger on a loop hike as you see all the different life stages of a mighty Sequoia. *1 hour, 1.5 mile walk, easy*

## Meadow Meander

Meet in front of the Kings Canyon Visitor Center for a guided tour around Bradley Meadow. Discover various plants and animals that call this mountain meadow home. *1 hour, ½ mile walk*
