Big Tree Talk

Meet a park ranger at the base of the General Grant Tree to find out what it takes to be one of the largest trees on earth! *20 minute talk*

Grant Tree Walk

Go on a leisurely walk to learn about the giant sequoias and why people have been coming to Grant Grove for centuries. Meet at the trailhead in the Grant Tree parking lot. *1 hour, ½ mile walk*

Kings Canyon: Beyond the Sequoias

There is more to Kings Canyon than big trees! Discover the animals, plants, geology, or history that makes Kings Canyon National Park unique. Meet at the Kings Canyon Visitor Center for this family-friendly ranger talk. *20-30 minute talk*

Solitude in the Sequoias

Meet at the Grant Tree parking lot to discover a quiet region of a magnificent Sequoia Grove. Join a ranger on a loop hike as you see all the different life stages of a mighty Sequoia.

How big? How old? What happens in a fire? Look for a ranger or volunteer naturalist along the Grant Tree Trail to have your questions answered. (**This is not a formal ranger program – look for a park ranger who will be “roving” the Grant Tree Trail.) *Informal, ongoing, 2 hours*
