Wolverton Stock Campsite Permit Application

Reservations are required for the use of the Wolverton Private Stock Campsites.

Complete this form and e-mail it to seki_wilderness_reservations@nps.gov to request a reservation. Please note that submitting this form does not guarantee a reservation. All reservation requests must be reviewed and confirmed by the park before arrival.

General Requirements:

Users are required to have stock to use these sites.

Reservation requests must be confirmed by the park no later than 5 business days before arrival.

California certified weed-free feed or precessed feed is required.

Payment

Reservations require payment of **\$22** per night. Fees are non-refundable once they have been processed. Once your reservation has been booked we will send you a link to Pay.Gov so you can complete payment. You will have 5 days from receipt of the link to complete payment or your reservation will be cancelled. DO NOT send credit card information via email with this application.

Stock Campsite Regulations:

Maximum of 6 people per site.

Maximum of 10 stock per site.

Maximum of 2 vehicles per site. Overflow parking is available at the Wolverton Trailhead.

All horse manure and uneaten feed must be raked up and disposed of daily.

Water trough must be emptied at the end of the stay.

Users are only permitted to feed commercially processed pellets, rolled grains, fermented hay, or California or Nevada certified weed-free forage (baled or loose hay, hay cubes).

Stock may not be tied to trees.

Night limit for these campsites is 7 nights per stay and 14 nights per season.

Quiet hours are from 10 PM to 6 AM.

Food and scented items must be securely stored.

Wolverton Stock Campsite Permit Application Instructions

Step 1: Fill out and e-mail the application form.

Download and fill out the form electronically. E-mail it as an attachment to seki_wilderness_reservations@nps.gov. In the subject line of your e-mail please use the title WOLVERTON STOCK CAMPING REQUEST. Please include a daytime phone number and e-mail address to avoid delays with your reservation. Only one application is needed per group. (Duplicate applications may result in duplicate, non-refundable charges.) To reserve more than one trip, fill out a separate application for each trip.

Step 2: E-mail Response

The Fee Office processes applications in the order in which they are received. All applicants will receive an e-mail response within 5 days of their request. The response will let you know if your request has been approved. It will also provide you with the dates available based on you listed preferences, the terms of use for stock campsites and the link to Pay.gov for payment of campsite fee.

Step 3: Payment of the \$22 per night fee must be submitted through Pay.Gov.

Once your reservation request has been received we will email you a custom link to Pay.Gov. Payment can be made by credit or debit card, bank account (ACH), Amazon, or PayPal account. **Read and print your Pay.Gov confirmation letter.** The fee is not refundable, not transferable to other parties or future years, and not for re-sale. You will have 5 business days after you receive the link to complete payment or your reservation request will be cancelled.

Step 4: Reservation Confirmation E-mail

Once the Fee Office verifies the processing of your payment you will receive a confirmation letter via e-mail. It will include additional details about how to access your stock campsite. Arrival cannot take place until the confirmation letter has been obtained. If you arrive without a reservation confirmation you will be asked to vacate the site.

Step 5: Bring your Pay.Gov payment confirmation AND your campsite reservation confirmation letter with you on your trip. If you have questions about the payment process, please contact the park at 559-565-4214 or 559-565-3184.
