SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR GUIDED BICYCLING

- 1. The CUA for Guided Bicycle Tours allows the CUA holder to conduct guided road-based bicycle tours in Shenandoah National Park. The use of a bicycle is prohibited except on park roads, in parking areas and routes designated for bicycle use.
- 2. When operating a bicycle during periods of low visibility, or while traveling through a tunnel, or between sunset and sunrise bicycles must exhibit a white light on the front and a red light on the rear of the bike. Reflectors alone do not provide adequate safety.
- 3. Individual rides should consist of no more than 100 cyclists. Groups should be no larger than 20 cyclists with at least a 15 minute interval between each group.
- 4. Support vehicles will stop only at designated parking areas except in emergency situations. The support vehicle will display company name on the side of the vehicle. <u>The support vehicle</u> <u>must travel at the speed of traffic, not at the speed of the bicycle group.</u>
- 5. During inclement weather, a Park Ranger may prohibit bicycles from entering onto Skyline Drive for safety purposes.
