SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR GUIDED ROCK CLIMBING

- 1. Maximum group size is 12 persons, including instructors. Climber to guide ratio will not exceed five (5) climbers for every one (1) guide.
- 2. Exercise due care and extreme caution when climbing above a park trail so that no objects are made to fall to the base of the climb.
- 3. No power equipment may be used to aid a climb (drills, saws, ratchets, etc.).
- 4. The holder shall be responsible to see that all members of the group are safely equipped.
- 5. No permanent anchors or bolts of any sort will be placed by the permit holder or his/her group.
- 6. Gardening and scrubbing of routes is prohibited. Chipping, gluing, marking, the removal of any naturally occurring materials, other modification or alteration of resource features is also prohibited.
- 7. Sanitation and Solid Waste Removal. The CUA holder and employees are responsible for the cleanliness of all climbing sites that have been used or are being used by the group they accompany.
