# **Tips for Your Visit**

- Plan ahead with the official NPS App. Be sure to download content for offline use before arriving in the Park as coverage is unreliable! Find out more information at: go.nps.gov/app
- Stay on the hiking trail and never climb around waterfalls.
- Fires are only allowed in park-built grates or fire rings. Fires must be fully extinguished.
- Never leave food or trash unattended, even for a few minutes. Secure all trash in bear-resistant trash cans or dumpsters.
- Drive the posted speed limit and be sure to pull completely off the road when viewing wildlife.
- Don't rely on your cell phone; coverage is unreliable.
- Drones are prohibited in all national parks.
- For future visits, get your entrance pass online: recreation.gov/sitepass/74293
- Be aware: cars and bikes share the road. Despite changes to Virginia laws, federal regulations require bicyclists to ride single file at all times in Shenandoah National Park.
