

## Suggested Hikes



### Hike: Upper Hawksbill

2.1-mile round trip, easiest, 1 1/2 hours hiking time, 520-foot elevation gain. Take Upper Hawksbill Trail to intersection with Byrds Nest 2 Road. Continue on road, following signs to the summit. From the summit, retrace your steps to return to the starting point. Near the summit, you will see Byrds Nest Shelter 2, a day-use-only shelter. Camping is not allowed on Hawksbill summit.



### Look for Trail Markers

You'll find these trail markers at all trailheads and intersections. The metal bands are stamped with directional and mileage information.

## Before You Go!

- Pets are not allowed on Fox Hollow Trail. Where allowed, pets must be on a leash at all times.
- Be sure you are physically able to complete the hike you've chosen.
- Take plenty of water—at least a quart per hour.
- Be sure you know your route. Free maps are available at entrance stations, visitor centers, and [www.nps.gov/shen](http://www.nps.gov/shen)
- When you return from your hike, check for ticks.
- Be sure someone knows where you are and when to expect your return.
- Leave what you find. Artifacts are protected by law.
- Please respect family cemeteries.
