# Short Train Rides

**Scranton Limited Train Ride:** Enjoy a half-hour train ride through the historic Delaware, Lackawanna & Western (DL&W) Scranton railroad yard and up a short piece of the mainline past the Lackawanna Station. Departs at 10:30, 11:30, 1:15, and 2:15.

**Nay Aug Limited Train Ride:** This 45-minute train ride travels through the DL&W railroad yard and up the historic mainline to Nay Aug Gorge, a National Natural Landmark. Departs at 10:30, 11:30, 1:15, and 2:15.

Motive power will be the steam locomotive Baldwin Locomotive Works #26 or historic diesel-electric locomotives.
