Boston and Maine Railroad, Dining Car #84.

Dining Car, #84. Class: DPA. Built by Pullman Car Company, December 1930 as part of the series #84 -- #87. 6-wheel trucks (heavyweight). Originally featured leaded windows and Federal style decor in the dining section copied from a house built in 1825 in Salem, MA. Renamed from "Maine" to "Mountaineer" after June 1947 remodeling as a diner-lounge while keeping the number 84. Seating: 22 in diner and 14 in lounge. First heavyweight diner placed in service on the B&M and the last retired in December 1959. Sold to Nelson Blount December 1959.
