Purchased as part of a series of locomotives replacing older, worn engines. Sold to Dansville & Mount Morris Railroad in 1936. Moguls were a popular configuration in the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries. Has Walschaert valve gear. Purchased for the New Jersey tourist railroad, the Black River and Western in 1960. Between 1968 and 1985 the Mogul passed through a series of private owners until it was sold to Steamtown Foundation. One of two surviving DL&W engines.
