




A Kite's-Eye View

See what a kite can see! Discover the National Parks of New York Harbor from the air! With park rangers, fly kites with cameras attached to take aerial photography (*like the photograph to your right*). See how the land has changed over time by comparing your photos with historic aerial photographs taken in the 1920s. (See your photos immediately after flying the kite. National Park Service staff will send you your photographs after your visit.)
