REMARKS.

1. Was soon after promoted to Brigadier General and assigned to duty elsewhere. In the Spring of 1862 he commanded First Brigade of Breckinridge's Division at Corinth, Mississippi for a short time; but was transferred to the Trans-Mississippi Department some time during the Summer and continued to serve there during the war.
2. See Roster of General Officers.
3. Was appointed Lieutenant Colonel, July 17, 1861, and promoted to Colonel, December 13, 1862. He was assigned to temporary duty with the Ninth Regiment in the Autumn of 1861 and fought with it at Shiloh, April 6 and 7, 1862. He rejoined his own regiment after it was exchanged and afterward resigned, October 19, 1863.
4. Was Captain of Company "C"; shortly after the battle of Chickamauga, Sept. 20, 1863, he was promoted to Major and on November 5, 1863, promoted to Lieutenant Colonel; he was painfully wounded at Resaca, Georgia on May 14, 1864, and received a slight wound at Dallas, Georgia, on May 28, 1864. On the fall of Colonel Moss at Jonesboro, Georgia, August 31, 1864, he was promoted to Colonel and commanded the Second Regiment until the close of the war.
5. Was Captain of Company "A"; on December 13, 1862 was promoted to Major and fought in that capacity at Stone River, Jackson and Chickamauga. After the fall of Lieut. Colonel. Hewitt, September 20, 1863, he was promoted to Lieut. Colonelcy, and a little later on the resignation of Colonel Johnson, to Colonel, October 19, 1863. He commanded the regiment in every subsequent battle up to August 31, 1864, when endeavoring to press forward upon the enemy's works, under their withering fire, he had an arm shattered and having been previously greatly debilitated by ill health, he directly became so weakened from loss of blood and excruciating pain that he could not drag himself away, nor could the infirmiry detail reach him without the almost certain loss of many lives; so he fell into the hands of the enemy and was carried to Marietta, Ga., where he suffered amputation and shortly afterwards died.
6. Was a Captain in a New York regiment when the Civil War commenced. He resigned his commission, however, with that regiment and on July 17, 1861, was elected a Major of Second Kentucky Infantry. He was promoted to the Lieutenant Colonelcy on December 13, 1862, and commanded the regiment at Stone River, Jackson and Chickamauga; at Stone River he was wounded, though not seriously; he fell at Chickamauga, Sept. 20, 1863. The following mention is from the report of that battle: "Lieut. Colonel James W. Hewitt in advance of his regiment and showing a devotion and daring entitled to the highest commendation, was killed."
7. He recruited Company "F" Second Regiment Infantry and was its first Captain; was promoted to Major after the battle of Chickamauga, September 20, 1863 and promoted to Lieutenant Colonel after the battle of Jonesboro, Georgia, August 31, 1864. The following is said of him in Green's Historic Families of Kentucky: "In prison, in camp, on the march, in the hottest fights of the bloody war; in victory and defeat, always uncomplaining, calm, energetic and daring, he exhibited the best qualities of a soldier."
8. Was appointed Captain and Assistant Quartermaster July, 1861, and served some time with this regiment, but was promoted to Major and Assistant Quartermaster in the Autumn and assigned to duty elsewhere.
9. Promoted from Company "H."
10. Appointed Captain and Assistant Commissary of Subsistence, July, 1861; served a short time with this regiment, after which he was assigned to the Staff of General S. B. Buckner and promoted to the rank of Major.
11. Served with the regiment until July 17, 1863, when he was assigned to duty as Chief Commissary of the Brigade; served in this capacity until after the death of General Ben Hardin Helm, when he entered upon post duty in Southwest Georgia. In the Winter of 1863-64 was made Chief Commissary on the Staff of General Lewis; was in the battle of Chickamauga as Volunteer Aide to General Ben Hardin Helm.
12. Resigned October 17, 1862 to command Graves' Battery of Artillery; was promoted to Major and Chief of Artillery, General John C. Breckinridge's Division; captured at Fort Donelson; wounded at Murfreesboro; killed at Chickamauga, September 20, 1863; honorable mention in general orders.
13. When Graves was transferred to the Artillery, he was succeeded by Lieut. Thomas E. Stake, of Company "B" as Acting Adjutant and on promotion of General Hanson, Lieut. Hake was appointed on his staff and Thomas E. Moss was commissioned as First Lieutenant and Adjutant, serving in that capacity to the end of the war.
14. Dr. Wible was a native of Nelson County, Ky., and was the first Surgeon of this regiment, joining the command at the beginning of the war. After serving with it for some time, he was ordered to assume charge of the Hess Hospital at Bowling Green, Ky., and in a short time was made Medical Director for the Central Army of Kentucky, in which capacity he acted some time; was again in charge of the wounded of the Second Regiment; was Post Surgeon at Huntsville, Alabama; assisted at battle of Shiloh; was Medical Inspector of the army and in early Winter of 1864, he relieved Surgeon Nichol on duty at Cutlibert, Georgia, where he remained until close of the war.
15. On the return of the Second Regiment from prison, Sept., 1862, he was appointed Surgeon, made vacant by the transfer of Dr. Steele.
16. Resigned in 1861.
17. Served with the Second Regiment until the trip to Rochester, when he was taken ill and after recovery was assigned to duty elsewhere.
18. Was on duty at Shiloh. While engaged in the rear of the line he learned that there was need of surgical care on the ground where his Battery (Byrne's) was in action, and thither he went under heavy fire and composedly took up the work. Shortly after this battle he was transferred to the Third Kentucky Infantry; subsequently to Cobb's Battery; next (October 1862) he was assigned to Second Kentucky and on 27th of November, 1862 was commissioned Assistant Surgeon.
20. Was on duty as Assistant Surgeon during last year of the war.
21. Resigned Sept. 20, 1862. (See Company "E," this regiment.)
22. Having joined the army in this capacity, he was found more than once pressing forward in the heat of battle sharing the hot exposure for the sake of the soldiers who fell. His friends remonstrated with him, but his response was: "Those who need my services first and most are those who fall first in the battles of my country. There are messages to mothers on the dying soldiers lips that would never be conveyed were I to wait until the shock was over." Finally his health became so bad he was forced to resign and quit the field.
