Resaca; May 14th enemy charged us and were repulsed thrice; on 15th fell back to Dallas via Calhoun; on 27th on Skirmish, Captain and 23 wounded; on 28th charged enemy, were repulsed; Lieutenant Freeman mortally wounded; on 6th to 15th on out post duty at Pine Mountain; on 18th fell back to Kenesaw Mountain; June to July 1st, constantly on skirmish; on July 3d commenced retreat; July 18th, moved into line and dug rifle pits; July 21st attacked the enemy and were repulsed with heavy loss, 1st Lieutenant and three men; on July 24th moved to city trenches at Atlanta, Ga.; on July 28th went to Jonesboro; on 31st charged the enemy and were repulsed, Corporal Branham killed; on September 1st repulsed enemy twice, were then overpowered in pits and captured, one Captain, one Lieutenant and twelve men; on 2d fell back towards Barnesville, all the officers of the Company captured.
