15. Was appointed 3d Sergeant at organization, Oct. 10, 1861, promoted to 1st Sergeant at reorganization, May 10, 1862; killed by enemy's sharpshooters at Kennesaw Mountain, June 20, 1864.

20. Was appointed 1st Corporal at organization, Oct. 10, 1861; was elected 2d Lieutenant at reorganization, May 10, 1862; wounded at Stone River, December 31, 1862, and severely wounded and permanently disabled at Intrenchment Creek, July 22, 1864.
21. Was appointed 1st Corporal, vice Wm. J. Shaw, promoted; was wounded at battle of Shiloh, April 7, 1862; died of disease at Chattanooga, Tennessee, May, 1863.
22. Was promoted from 2d Corporal; severely wounded at battle of Shiloh, April 7, 1862; recovered and rejoined command and was again wounded and permanently disabled at battle of Chickamauga, September 20, 1863; awarded Medal of Honor.
