REMARKS

1. Organized regiment at Bowling Green, Ky.; designated as the Fifth Regiment Kentucky Infantry, and elected Colonel; commissioned, Oct. 3, 1861; was recommended for promotion to Brigadier General, April 24, 1862, in special communication to General P. G. T. Beauregard, by General John C. Breckinridge, for gallant conduct on the field of Shiloh; gallantly and effectively commanded the brigade at Baton Rouge, La., after the disabling of General Ben Hardin Helm, by an accident; was wounded at Baton Rouge, Aug. 5, 1862; especially commended for meritorious conduct at Hartsville, Dec. 7, 1862, by Generals John C. Breckinridge and John H. Morgan; was tendered a commission as Brigadier General by the Confederate government, but declined; resigned from service, April 22, 1863.
2. Was promoted successively from Captain of Co. "A"; was wounded at Shiloh, April 6, 1862; especially commended for gallantry at Shiloh, in special report of his commanding officer; was elected to be Lieutenant Colonel at reorganization, May 14, 1862, and promoted to Colonel, April 22, 1863, vice Col. Thomas H. Hunt, resigned; was again wounded at Chickamauga, Sept. 20, 1863.
3. Was promoted to Lieutenant Colonel at reorganization of the command, May 14, 1862, at Corinth, Miss; promoted to Colonel, April 22, 1863, vice Col. Thomas H. Hunt, resigned.
4. Was promoted successively from Captain of Company "B"; was elected Major at reorganization of the command, May 15, 1862, at Corinth, Miss.; promoted to Lieutenant Colonel, April 22, 1863, vice Lieut. Colonel John W. Caldwell, promoted to Colonel.
5. Was serving as Assistant Adjutant General on Staff of General Simon Bolivar Buckner; was assigned to duty as Superintendent of Enlistments and Recruits and temporarily with this regiment.
6. Was elected Major at reorganization of the command, May 15, 1862, at Corinth, Miss.
7. Was promoted successively from Captain of Company "D" and made Major, April 22, 1863, vice Major John Cripps Wickliffe, promoted to Lieut. Colonel; he was wounded at Shiloh, April 6, 1862, and permanently disabled by wounds at Jonesboro, August 31, 1864.
8. Was appointed and assigned to Col. Thos. H. Hunt's regiment as Surgeon, Oct. 6, 1861, and served as regimental surgeon until after the battle of Baton Rouge, Aug. 5, 1862; then assigned to staff of General John C. Breckinridge; left with wounded after Murfreesboro; was appointed medical inspector for the cavalry of the Army of Tennessee, and later assigned as Chief Surgeon, Martin's Division, Wheeler's Corps.
9. Was assigned as Surgeon of this regiment as successor to Dr. John Ed. Pendleton.
10. Was promoted to be Surgeon from Assistant Surgeon, March 21, 1864.
12. Was assigned to be Assistant Surgeon of this regiment at organization and promoted to Surgeon, March 21, 1864.
13. Served with 6th Regiment Kentucky Infantry from Dec., 1863, until April, 1864, and after with the 9th Regiment to the close of the war.
14. Was 1st Lieutenant of Company "A"; promoted to Captain and Assistant Quartermaster, May 17, 1862.
15. Served as A. Q. M. of this regiment until February, 1862, when he resigned.
16. Was a member of Co. "B" and appointed A. C. S.; dropped August 2, 1862.
17. Was, after service with this regiment, appointed as Captain and Chief Commissary on Staff of General John C. Breckinridge.
18. Was Chaplain of Crew's Tennessee Battalion, until that organization was disbanded after the battle of Shiloh, when assigned to this regiment, and in spring of 1863 was assigned to duty in hospitals.
19. Was appointed Adjutant, January 28, 1862, and mortally wounded at Shiloh, April 7, 1862 and died from wounds at Memphis, Tenn., shortly after.
20. Was 1st Lieutenant of Co. "H" and appointed Adjutant, June 1, 1862; mortally wounded at Stone River, Dec. 30, 1862; died, January 2, 1863.
21. Was promoted to Adjutant from Sergeant Major, vice Adjutant Henry M. Curd; to rank, March 1, 1863; was wounded at Shiloh and Chickamauga, and taken prisoner at Intrenchment Creek, July 22, 1864.
22. Was a member of Company "A," and promoted to Ensign, April 21, 1864; wounded at Intrenchment Creek, July 22, 1864.
23. Was appointed Sergeant Major, Oct. 2, 1861, and promoted to 1st Lieutenant and Adjutant to rank from March 1, 1863.
24. Was a member of Company "B," and promoted to Sergeant Major to rank from April, 1863; was wounded at Shiloh and prisoner of war at Jonesboro, Ga., Sept. 1, 1864.
26. Was enlisted in Company "B," appointed Quartermaster Sergeant, Nov. 1, 1861, and served in that capacity to the close of the war.
27. Was enlisted in Company "A"; appointed Ordnance Sergeant, January 30, 1864, and served in that capacity to the close of the war.
28. Was enlisted in Co. "B," appointed Chief Musician for the regiment, March 8, 1863.
