THREE YEARS' SERVICE.

FIELD AN

This Regiment was organized at Athens, Ohio, from August 16 to September 28, 1861, to serve three years. It was mustered out November 9, 1864, by reason of expiration of term of service, and the veterans and recruits consolidated with the veterans and recruits of the Thirty-fifth Ohio Infantry and the consolidated force designated the Eighteenth Veteran Regiment Ohio Infantry. The Eighteenth Veteran Regiment was organized October 31, 1864, by consolidation of the veterans and recruits of the First, Second, Eighteenth, Twenty-fourth and Thirty-fifth Regiments Ohio Infantry. It was mustered out of service October 9, 1865, in accordance with orders of the War Department.

The official list of battles in which the Eighteenth Regiment bore an honorable part is not yet published by the War Department, but the following list has been compiled after careful research during the preparation of this work:



