

James Harvey Conine, Co K 65th Regiment. Ohio Volunteer Infantry (private)

December, 1862 saw Nolensville occupied by Confederate General John Wharton. Main camp was located on the Page Plantation between Nolensville and Triune with advanced camps at Knob Gap and Nolensville. On December 26, 1862, the Union Army, under the command of General Rosecrans, began a southern advance from Nashville which would eventually culminate in the Battle of Stone's River in Murfreesboro. General Alexander McCook commanded the Union 14th Army to advance directly down Nolensville Pike. At mid-morning on Friday, December 26, 1862, the Union 14th Army encountered General Wharton's Confederate cavalry at Nolensville. After a sharp skirmish and several rounds of artillery, the Confederates became quickly outnumbered over ten to one and fell back to Knob Gap and then further back to Triune. Over the next several days, Union and Confederate troops made their way towards Murfreesboro where they collided in the Battle of Stone's River on December 31, 1862, leaving over 22,000 killed, wounded, or missing - one out of four who entered the battle. Looks like James Harvey was in the Triune area at the time of the battle that will be re-enacted. Can't find any reference that his company fought.

More info of his service:

THREE YEARS' SERVICE.

THIS Regiment was organized in the State of Ohio, at large, from October 3 to December 14, 1861, to serve three years. On the expiration of its term of service the original members (except veterans) were mustered out, and the organization, composed of veterans and recruits, retained in service until November 30, 1865, when it was mustered out in accordance with orders from the War Department.
