

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

Act of April 19, 1908,
Amended by Act of September 8, 1916.

On this 3d day of December, 1917, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace, within and for the County and State aforesaid, Catherine Ganger, who, being duly

sworn by me according to law, declares that she is 68 years of age and that she was born April 27, 1849 at Goshen Elkhart County Ind

That she is the widow of Daniel Ganger, who enlisted November 14, 1862 at Goshen Ind., under the name of Daniel Ganger

as a Private 4th (Rank.) in Company "D" 57 Regt. Ind. Vol. Inf.

and was honorably discharged August 16th, 1863, (Here state company and regiment, if in the Army; or vessels, if in the Navy.) having served ninety days or more during the CIVIL WAR.

That he also served as a private in Co "D" 22d Regt. Ind Vol Inf Infantry & discharged therefrom January 24, 1864, by reason of lack of orders (Here give a complete statement of all other military, naval, or coast guard service, if any, at whatever time rendered.)

That otherwise than as herein stated said soldier (or sailor) was not employed in the United States service.

That she was married to said soldier (or sailor) in Jan. 1866, under the name of Catherine Crife, at Goshen Indiana, by Rev Andrew Bigler; that she had not been previously married; that he had not been previously married


