Thank you for taking the time to answer my questions regarding a possible family member involved in the battle in 1862.

I believe that Joseph Graeff married Margaret C Bullock Concordia parish , LA on 08-22-1857 and he enlisted in Company C, 25th Louisiana Infantry 03-18-1862 in Monterey, Concordia, Louisiana. On Fold3 we also found that he was hospitalized in Eaglesville and died there on 12-21-1862. We have been trying to find his burial information and also documents that would tie him definitely to Margaret.

I was able to get my scanner operating again so have attached the confederate army records that we were able to locate. Any additional information you may have that would help in our search would be greatly appreciated.
