stead, to receive and collect of the Confederate States of America, all the arrears of pay, etc.,  
that may be found due the said deceased from the said Confederate States, and which the un-  
dersigned is by law entitled to receive, hereby giving to my said attorney full power to do and  
perform all and every act and thing whatsoever and necessary to be done in and about the  
premises as fully as I might or could do if personally present.
