Mary Ellen (Glover) Labaw, of the fifth generation and seventh child of William and Catherine (Walker) Glover was born on October 31, 1844, at the old Glover homestead in Troy Township, about five miles northwest of Stone Bluff. She received her education in the township schools and taught subscription schools. At an early age she united with the Osborn Prairie Church.

On February 6, 1862 occurred her marriage by Rev. Thomas Osborn to Derrick Labaw and they went to housekeeping on the Simon B. Labaw farm in Shawnee Township. He was born on March 6, 1840.

In August of the same year he was called to war. He was killed in the battle of Murpheesborough on December 31, 1862.

To this union was born one daughter, Barkalow Annie, on February 10, 1863.

Aunt Ellen passed away on March 6, 1931, and was buried in Oak Hill Cemetery, at Riley, Indiana.
