We have received a form addressed to General Services Administration, mailed by you, in which you make inquiry concerning the above-named veteran.

Our records show that Alexander L. Sloan was born January 18, 1850, at Washington County, Iowa, and served in the Army as Private, Company "F," 44th Indiana Infantry (also shown as Company "F," 139th Regiment of Indiana), from May 1, 1864, to September 28, 1864, and from February 20, 1865, to September 14, 1865. He died April 21, 1932, in McLeansboro, Illinois.

His former wife was Teresa Hudson, who died in 1885; he subsequently married Mary E. Wheeler, who was previously married to John James, who survived him and was granted a pension commencing April 12, 1937, which she received until her death in September, 1948.

We trust that this is the information you desire.
