 I, *John Reiker* born in *Tuscarawas Co*
 in the State of *Ohio* aged *Eighteen* years,
 and by occupation a *Farmer* Do HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE to have
 volunteered this *Eleventh* day of *August* 1862 to serve
 as a Soldier in the ARMY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, for the period of THREE
 YEARS, unless sooner discharged by proper authority: Do also agree to accept such bounty, pay,
 rations, and clothing, as are, or may be, established by law for volunteers. And I, *John*
Reiker do solemnly swear, that I will bear true faith and allegiance
 to the United States of America, and that I will serve them honestly and faithfully against all their
 enemies or opposers whomsoever; and that I will observe and obey the orders of the President of the
 United States, and the orders of the officers appointed over me, according to the Rules and Articles
 of War.
