

The 99th Regt O.V.I. went into the action on the 2d of January 1863 with 369 men Rank and file. The Regt lost as the foregoing report Shows, one Commissioned Officer and Eleven Enlisted men Killed, Three Commissioned Officers and 41 Enlisted men Wounded, one Commissioned Officer and 35 Enlisted men are missing, Of this number some are known to have been wounded on the field and some to be prisoners in the hands of the Enemy. After the Regt was compelled to fall back, I found that with but few exceptions the men rallied and went back into the action. The conduct of the Officers and men of the Regt was all that could be asked and I might do injustice to some of to mention particular instances of good conduct. Col Swaine was in Command and is wounded and absent from the Regt Sends back word that he was well Satisfied with the conduct of all the Officers and men of his Command and that they obeyed every order which he gave with promptness.
