Dear Mr. Magee:

Early last year I wrote to you for information on the burial site of Colonel George W. Roberts, USA, who was killed in action at Murfreesboro in December, 1862. You replied that no grave site was listed for Colonel Roberts in the National Cemetery at Murfreesboro. You also requested that, if I located the final burial site of Colonel Roberts to inform you of this. I am pleased to report to you that Colonel Roberts is buried in Oaklands Cemetery, West Chester, Pennsylvania. For further identification, Colonel Roberts was a member of the 42nd Illinois Infantry Regiment and was commanding a brigade at the Battle of Murfreesboro.
