CIVIL WAR RECORD OF WILLIAM CASTLEBERRY CRUNK

3rd CORP. CO. E, 11 REGT TENNESSEE INFANTRY

ENLISTED AGE 25YR. This company was known at various times as CAPT MALLORY'S COMPANY, CAPT JAMES' COMPANY AND COMPANY E, 11TH Regiment Tennessee Infantry. Mustered in NASHVILLE, TN by MAJOR SCHUDDER May 18, 1861.

Organized for State service in June 1, 1861 and transferred to Confederate States in Aug, 1861. Was paid as Corporal July & Aug of 1862. Company muster roll Dec 1862, Jan and Feb 1863 listed as absent- wounded in shoulder at battle of Murfreesboro, TN. and left in vicinity. Company muster roll Mar & Apr 1863 listed as present. Muster roll near Shelbyville May 14, 1863 lists him until Jul & Aug 1863 listed as deserted. William next listed as Prisoner of War Oct 8, 1863 Nashville, TN. , captured near Charlotte, TN. Sept 26, 1863. Sent to Military prison Louisville, Ky. Oct 10, 1863. Forwarded to Camp Morton, Indianapolis.

Roll of Prisoners of War Camp Morton, Ind. Dec 8, 1863 states captured in Dickson co., TN. , Desires to take the Oath and return to his home. "Recommended" by A.J. Guthridge CAPT. 48th Ind. Vols. Name appears on Oath of Allegiance to the United States sworn to at Camp Morton, Ind., May 18, 1865. Lists place of residence Smeedville, TN. complexion dark; hair black; eyes black; height 5ft. 9 1/4 in.

ref in killed ,wounded and missing in Maj. Gen Mccown's Division, A.T., at battle in front of Murfreesboro, Tenn., Dec 31, 1862. listed Shelbyville apr 20, 1863 : wounded in shoulder severly.
