notification must include the name of the Offeror exactly as it will be provided in the Offeror's Transmittal Letter or the name of the individual who will sign the proposal on behalf of the Offeror.

Submission of an electronic proposal

Prior to the electronic submission deadline, you will receive a welcome email message from the Service's Microsoft Teams platform at the email address you provided when you notified the Service of your intent to submit a proposal. You must accept the invitation before you can access the Teams site to upload your proposal.
