At the entrance to the rain forest, stands the Frog/Raven Pole. Although some interpretations describe this as a legend pole showing Raven as the mischief-maker, sources indicate that it is a Haida crest pole displaying the Raven and Frog. Recent research indicates that Edward Scott of the Kaigani Haida village of Kilinkwan donated the original pole to Governor Brady for the people of Alaska.
