**Description:** Deep walnut, gesso and gilt liner. 2 small pieces missing ca.0.71 cm front right middle and left, near top. Contains lithographic print HAFE 13832.

**Object Name:** Frame, associated with HAFE 13831

**Description:** Deep walnut, gesso and gilt liner. Minute cracks, areas on edges rough. Small pieces missing. 3 small nail holes in liner. Originally contained HAFE 13831, now disassociated.

**Description:** "The Pursuit", two men on horseback engaged in a high-speed chase across prairie. Colored lithographic with white border, after painting by A. F. Tait; engraved by L. Maurer; published by N. Currier, 1856.

Marks: "L. Maurer 5.5", "A. F. Tait", "entered according to act of Congress 1856, by N. Currier", "The Pursuit", "New York, published by N. Currier".

Frame number HAFE 13830 print companion HAFE 13832, disassociated with frame.
