**Description:** Pottery. Gold luster paint. Nouveau motif. Painted portraits of Lincoln, McKinley, Garfield. Fairfax pottery?

(Washington) holding and displaying symbols of freemasonry. Condition: cropped to irregular border of image. Stains along right edges and lower right. Tear, lower right. Mounted, with glue?, onto board.

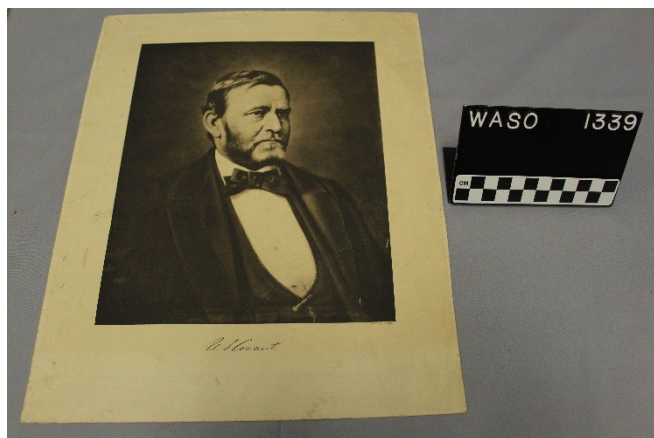


**Object Name:** Plaque

Stamped on back is "ART NOVELTY CO.", "HAMILTON, OHIO." Plaque is painted with bronze powder. Grant's likeness is painted with black, grey, blue, and flesh tones. He wears a blue uniform with three stars on shoulder. Residue on left side of Grant where a label was adhered.

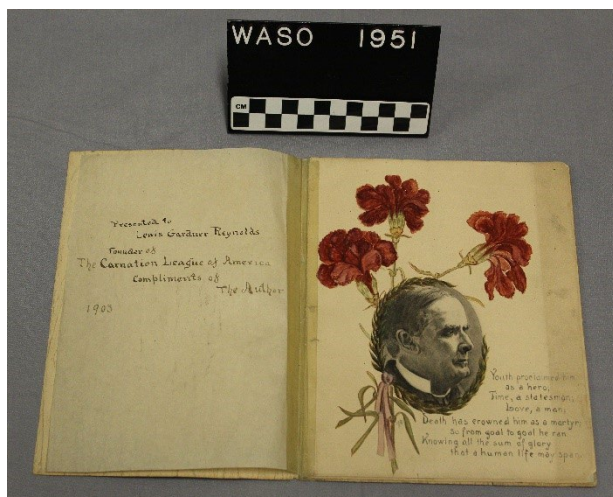
**Object Name:** Needlework Picture

Top center (gold) "LET US HAVE PEACE", bottom center (gold) title, bottom right, very poor condition. Top severely cracked. Some pieces & embroidery missing. Faded. Also in image are Ares, god of war and Clio, muse of history.

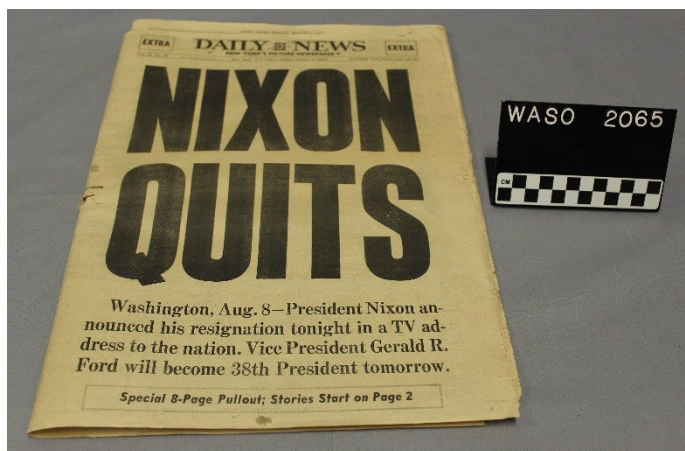

Glass is dirty and scratched. Back of picture is dirty with sticky residue and piece of masking tape with "10,055" written on it.
