


Map 1: Location Map

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
Map 2: Land Ownership and Overview of Developed Areas

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

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

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


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Map 7: New Baldwin Home Site





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

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
Map 10: Administrative Area

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






Figure 17: Olivia Breitha admission photo, Kalihi Hospital, 1934 (The Estate of Olivia Robello Breitha)
