



- Thought to have gone extinct in 1908.
- Historic Distribution:
- Small populations rediscovered in 1998 on SJI and Lopez island.

# Cattle Point Road Realignment



- Road set up 300 feet up the hillside
- New road will protect from further erosion for the next 100 years
- Seeds used in stabilization of old road cut and increase habitat for Island Marble butterfly
