#### Location

*Latitude 41.25° Longitude -73.45° . 735 Nod Hill Road, Wilton, CT, USA. Weir Farm is not far from New York City. You can get there by train in 2 hours.*

#### Place

*Artists lived at Weir Farm. They liked to paint the landscape. There are many buildings, and the house and studios are painted red. Weir Farm is part of the National Park Service.*

#### Human-Environment Interaction

*Julian Alden Weir made a little studio, called the Palace Car, where he could paint when it was cold. The people who lived at Weir Farm grew crops and raised animals for food. They created a pond where they could enjoy water sports.*

#### Movement

*People used to travel to Weir Farm on horses and trains. The families invited friends to talk about art and ideas. They painted with their friends too. Visitors still come to Weir Farm to learn about its history and artists still come to paint.*
