



Stock Use and Service Guide



Riding and Services near the Park

Bringing a horse to the Theodore Roosevelt National Park area? This guide is intended to inform you of some special regulations in Theodore Roosevelt National Park and to help you find horse-related services such as boarding, camping, and feed near the park.

Regulations

Weed Seed Free Feed and Grain

All feed must be carried in and supplied by horse and pack animal users. All feed must meet North American Weed Management Association Standards for Certified Weed Seed Free Feed. Use of pelletized feed is allowed.

Camping with Horses

Horses and pack animals may not be kept overnight in any established roadside pullout, campground, or picnic area, with the exception of the Roundup Group Horse Campground. Backcountry permits are required for backcountry camping.

Resource Protection and Sanitation

At parking lots and other loading areas, manure must be picked up before departing. Horses must be picketed or hobbled at least 200 feet from water, and where there will be minimal vegetation damage.

Upon vacating a campsite, manure must be scattered. Manure must be removed immediately if dropped in or near any spring or non-flowing water source. Stock may not be tied to trees, enclosure fences, or campground facilities.

Closed Areas

Horses and pack animals are permitted throughout the park except the following areas: Caprock Coulee Trail, Coal Vein Trail, Little Mo Nature Trail, Painted Canyon Nature Trail, Ridgeline Trail, Skyline Vista Trail, and Wind Canyon Trail.

Other Regulations

Horses or pack animals that become lost or die must be reported the same day. Horse and pack animal use in any part of the park may be prohibited when, at the discretion of the Superintendent, such action is necessary to protect park values or visitors.
