New Hours Announced for Thomas Stone National Historic Site

Beginning in 2015, Thomas Stone National Historic Site will be open Thursday – Sunday, March – December and will be closed January and February. The new hours will allow park management to refocus resources on periods of highest visitation, continue to offer high-quality visitor services/educational programming and host additional special events during the summer.

Visitation to the park is typically at its lowest during January and February. Highest visitor use throughout the year is on weekends, with Thursdays and Fridays seeing steady visits by school groups in the spring and fall.
