



Timpanogos Cave

Student Conduct Rules

Please read the following visitor rules to all participating classes, sign and send back with your application:

In order for this to be an enjoyable visit for you and your students, please review the following rules before your trip to Timpanogos Cave National Monument:

1. Students must stay with adult chaperones at all times.
2. No running! Running can lead to painful falls and is dangerous on the cave trail.
3. Stay on the cave trail at all times. Shortcutting causes damage to the thin canyon soils and loss of vegetation, often leaving noticeable scars for many years. It also causes rockfall that may injure visitors below.
4. Rockfall can occur at any time on the cave trail. Rockfall may be heard before it is seen, so pay attention as you are hiking the cave trail. High rockfall areas are marked with red stripes; do not stop in these areas.
5. Be aware of steep cliffs. Walk on the inside of the trail and away from the cliff edge.
6. Do not throw or kick rocks off the cave trail.
7. Cave pools are not wishing wells. Do not throw anything in the pools. Foreign materials introduce new bacteria. The native bacteria may not be able to compete with the foreign bacteria, and thus, may be eliminated.
8. Tobacco use of any kind is not permitted anywhere in the caves.
9. Gum, food and drinks (other than plain water) are not allowed in the cave system. The food can attract animals not normally found in the cave.
10. Do not touch cave formations, walls, or ceilings. Oils and dirt from hands can permanently polish, damage, and stain the caves.
11. Do not collect, pick or take anything from the park.

A fee waiver may be revoked and a bill for collection sent to your school if your group does not follow the rules and/or behaves inappropriately.
