

Tonto National Monument Pet Rules

1. Dogs are allowed on the Lower Cliff Dwelling Trail, the parking lot, and the picnic area.
2. If you are thirsty, so is your pup! Please bring enough water for yourself and your pets while hiking.
3. Do the hand test! If the pavement is too hot for the back of your hand, it is too hot for your dog's paws!
4. Law prohibits leaving dogs in vehicles or leaving your vehicle idling every day of the year regardless of weather.
5. Remember to always keep your pup on a leash, pick up your poop, and be aware of your surroundings!
