The Climate Strategies Forum is a 3-day training workshop presented by the [Association of Climate Change Officers \(ACCO\)](#). The [Climate Strategies Forum](#) is the ACCO's premier training event, featuring formal climate change preparedness for credit applicable to credentials issued under the CCO Certification program. The Forum also features a suite of keynote conversations, a Women's Climate Collaborative speed mentoring session, CCO Roundtable sessions, networking events, a tools and methodologies showcase and a tabletop exhibition. ### CLIMATE STRATEGIES FORUM OBJECTIVES:
