Climate Fundamentals Academy *Training Workshop # 1*

Northern California, San Francisco Bay Area – June 14-15, 2016

The Climate Fundamentals Academy is a three-part series of two-day training workshops presented by the [Association of Climate Change Officers](#) (ACCO). Attendance in the series enables the participant to satisfy all requirements for the Climate Governance Certificate, a credential issued through ACCO's CCO™ Certification Program. The series will be offered in the San Francisco Bay Area in 2016/17. The first workshop will take place June 14-15, with subsequent two-day workshops scheduled for fall 2016 and winter 2016/17. Participants are free to attend one or all workshops in the series. Tuition will be paid for interested National Park Service employees to attend.

The first workshop in the series provides a primer on climate science, identifying climate hazards, conducting vulnerability assessments, leveraging climate change data and tools, and understanding the energy-water-food nexus. This workshop enables decision makers across roles and functions to develop a better understanding of how the implications of climate change intersect with their decision making. Workshop participants will learn from experts about the implications of climate change with a regional focus added for the Northern California Region.

WORKSHOP #1 OBJECTIVES:

- Identify the key principles of climate science
- Describe types of climate hazards
- Articulate the steps in conducting a vulnerability assessment
- Explain the energy-water-food nexus and why it is important
- Describe how to leverage climate change data and tools for managing natural areas

PARTICIPANTS: Park Superintendents and Managers, Natural and Cultural Resource Managers, Facilities Management Personnel, Park Planners, Interpretation, Communication, and Education staff.

LOCATION: San Francisco State University at Westfield, San Francisco Centre, 835 Market Street, 6th Floor, San Francisco, CA 94103.

DATES: June 14-15, 2016. Class times are 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM both days.

TRAVEL COSTS: No Tuition. Travel paid by benefitting account. Lodging is \$250; M&IE is \$74. Participants will be responsible for finding their own lodging.
