



Dr. John Y. Simon was the editor of the Ulysses S. Grant Papers and executive director of the Ulysses S. Grant Association from 1962 until his death in 2008. He edited and published 28 annotated volumes of Grant's letters and papers. He also edited Julia Dent Grant's memoirs and was the author of over 100 articles. His scholarship on Grant was indispensable to Ulysses S. Grant NHS. This event will honor Dr. Simon and his life's work.
